We provide humanitarian access to over 30,000 patients in 70+ underserved countries, distributing over 10 million daily doses of lifesaving treatment each year.

## Why we're here

While an estimated 60% of cancer cases occur in low- and middle-income countries, only 5% of global spending on cancer is directed to these countries.\*

Many cancer deaths are preventable with today's treatment options, but for thousands of patients in lower-income countries, treatment is out of reach. Our direct-to-patient drug donation model bridges access to today's most innovative and effective cancer therapies for chronic myeloid leukemia (CML) and treatable chronic cancers.

Also, did you know that cancer is the second cause of death globally? Providing access to innovative cancer treatment in countries without access has the potential to save thousands of lives not only today but in years to come.
