
HPV Awareness Campaign

- An initiative of IPVS in collaboration with over 80 partner organizations from around the world, the campaign is guided by the IPVS Campaign Advisory Committee chaired by Dr. Joel Palefsky
- + We created this campaign because:
 - HPV effects everyone but too few people in the world understand HPV and how they are affected by it
 - Around 475.000 people per year die from HPV-related cancer, and many of these deaths can be prevented
 - Awareness and education are important first steps toward mobilizing action to stop HPV


